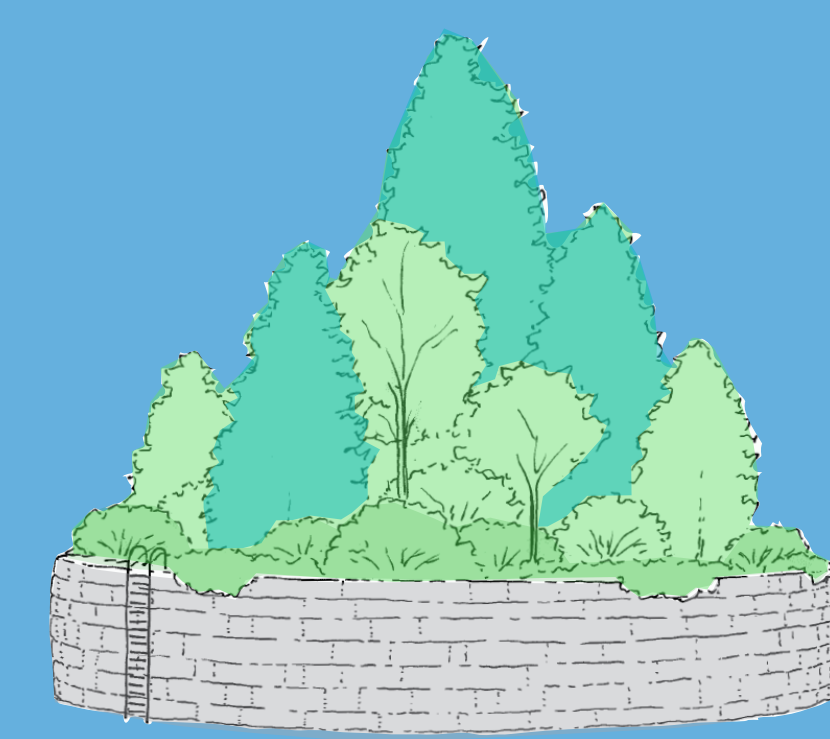

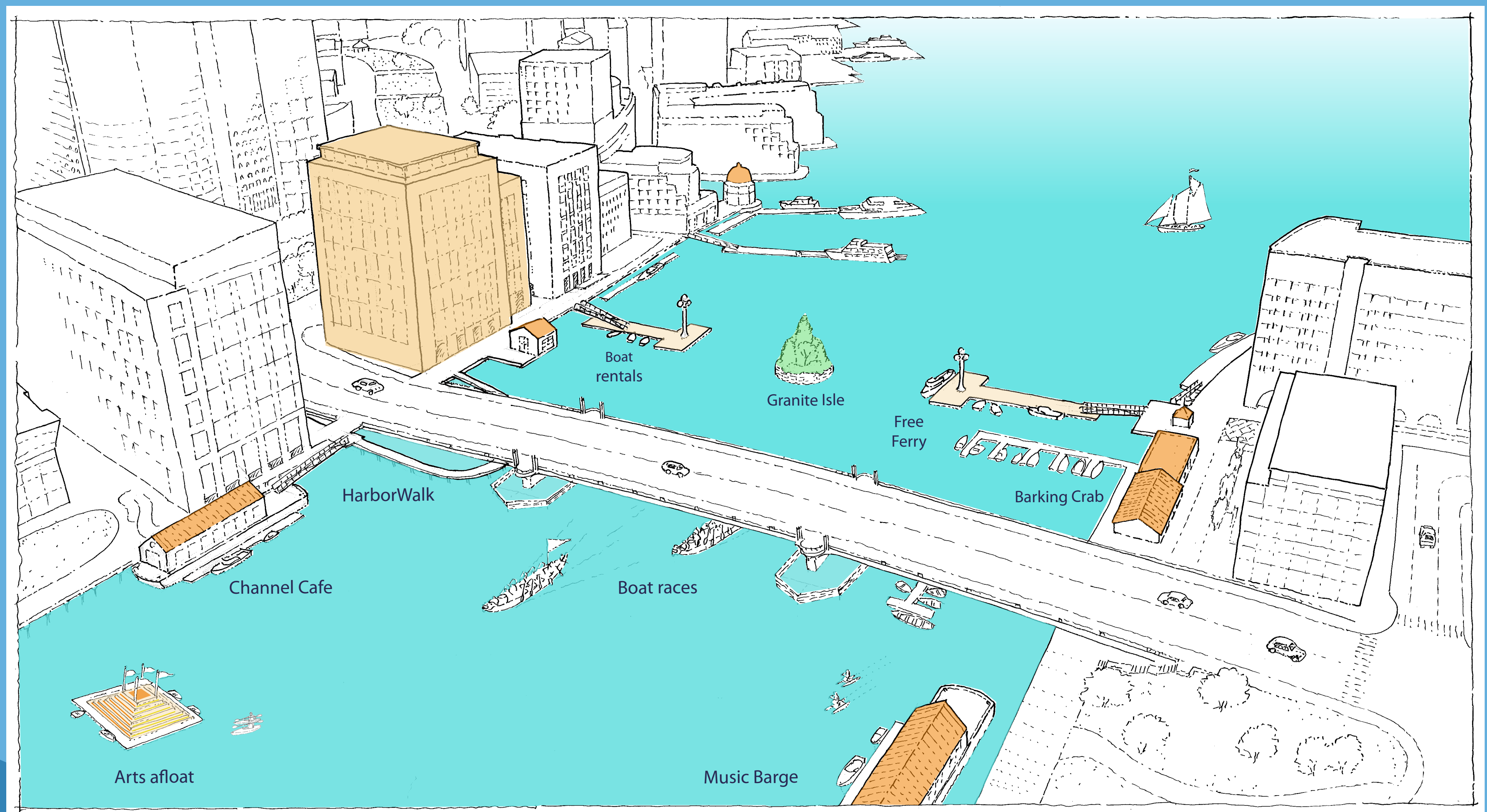
Floating platforms for cafes, performances venues, exhibits, outdoor
sports, and other public uses would be supported by private developers



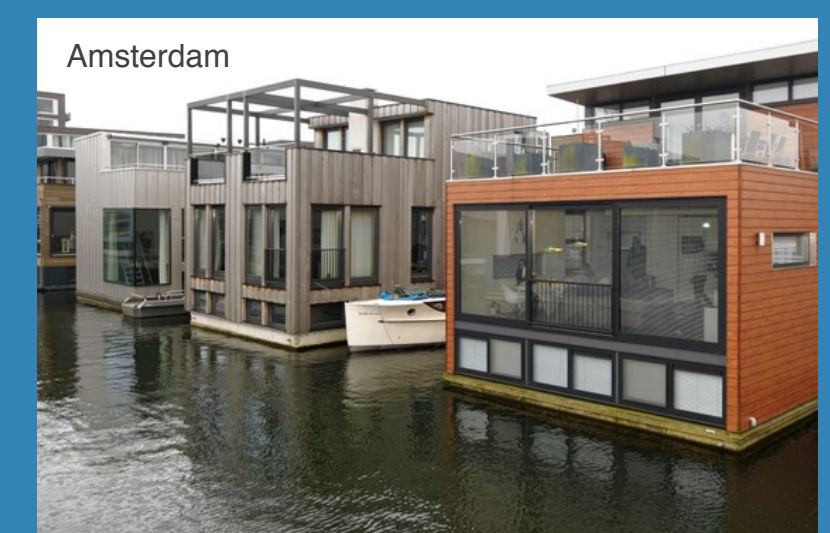
Convert the granite foundation to a
