
Northern Avenue

Design Concept

The Northern Avenue Lookout would create a point of interest where visitors and locals alike could take in the blue expanse of Boston Harbor as well as the history and beauty of the city along Fort Point Channel. The bridge is composed of a roadway suspended from an anticlastic catenary arch, with a transparent orb crowning the arch. This orb is an accessible viewpoint that would provide a new vantage point for the city.

The View

The Lookout is a large (30 foot tall) transparent sphere that would create panoramic views for those inside. It would be accessed from the road via ramps cut into each arm of the arch, and then through a door at the base of the sphere. Visitors to The Lookout would be perched above the channel, privy to a unique view both into the city and out towards the Atlantic.
